

LOCAL FUNERALS.

MR. CHARLES CAVE.

The funeral took place on Wednesday last of Mr. Charles Cave, whose death occurred on Saturday, January 28th, at his residence, 29, Abbey-road, after a short illness, patiently borne. Deceased was held in high esteem in the neighbourhood, as was evidenced by the many drawn blinds as the cortege left the house.

The first part of the service was held in Wesley Church, Christ Pieces, where a large gathering of representatives of the University Engineering Laboratories, where deceased had for many years been employed, had assembled. The interment took place at Mill-road Cemetery. The Rev. Harold Beales officiated at the church and graveside.

The coffin bore brass mounts, and was inscribed: "Charles Cave, died January 28th, 1928, aged 70 years."
