SPECIAL ADVICE FOR LITTER PICKING

- Always wear gloves, stout shoes, and appropriate clothes.
- Do not fill any plastic sack more than half full.

GENERAL ADVICE

Please take care at all times whilst enjoying your visit to the Cemetery, and remember to treat it with respect as it is a consecrated graveyard.

- Children and vulnerable adults: The safety of you, and any children or vulnerable adult
 accompanying you, is your responsibility. The FOMRC does not accept any liability for any loss,
 damage or accident that you and/or they may suffer.
- 2. **Uneven paths and surfaces**: These may be uneven, watch your step, and take particular care in icy or muddy conditions.
- 3. **Long grass and/or rough ground**: These may conceal trip and/or health hazards eg grave kerbstones, litter, dog dirt, glass, discarded needles and/or other drug equipment. Do not venture into long grass in sandals or put your hand anywhere you cannott see clearly.
- 4. **Needles and drug equipment**: Do NOT touch any needles or other drug equipment. If you find any needles or drug equipment report it to a committee member and ring 01223 457000 to report the location, so that Cambridge City Council can arrange for its disposal.
- 5. **Monuments and gravesets**: Remember that though stone looks strong, the monuments are old, fragile and in some cases crumbling. Do not lean or climb on them, and try not to walk on the gravesets.
